## IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

Coaches and players are reminded that all prep school play is governed by USSRA rules, which require that *squash players wear suitable eye protection at all times while on court.*

This means players must wear eye protection “designed for athletics with a polycarbonate lens.”

Many prescription eyeglasses *do not* meet this definition, either because of glass lenses or because of a wire-rim or similarly insubstantial frame.

Players on court without suitable eye protection risk catastrophic injury and their coaches and schools are exposed to liability.

Players without eye protection matching the USSRA standard will not be allowed to compete in the NEISA Championships.
